| Day 1 | | | Overnight flight from London to Delhi. |
| Day 2 | Arrive Delhi & transfer to accommodation. | Safety training, followed by sightseeing in New Delhi. May include: India Gate, Gandhi's House & Dilli Haat Craft Market. | Dinner, often at National Arts Centre. |
| Day 3 | After breakfast further training then to Old Delhi! May include a visit to Fr Ravi's shelter. | Take a rickshaw tour of Chandni Chowk, to include a Jain temple and the spice market | Overnight in Delhi. |
| Day 4 | After breakfast transfer to the Aravali Eco Camp. | Visits to local villages to learn local crafts or music & dance | Overnight in Eco-lodges. |
| Day 5 | Visit local villages, schools and farms. Plan your programme of activities and games which provide an insight into local culture and traditions. | | Evening of dance & music. |
| Day 6 | After breakfast Travel to Agra visiting the deserted town of Fatehpur Sikri en route. | | Overnight in Agra. |
| Day 7 | Up early to see the Taj Mahal and the Red Fort. | After lunch transfer to Jaipur. | Overnight in Jaipur. |
| Day 8 | Elephant ride up to the Amber Palace. | Afternoon of sightseeing and shopping in local bazaars. | Evening visit to Chokhi Dhani Rajasthani themed village. |
| Day 9 | Return to Delhi. | Free day in Delhi – you choose where and what you want to do! | Final meal in Delhi, often at the Revolving Restaurant. |
